YANKEE GRC Membership

The application procedure to become a voting member of **YANKEE GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB** is as follows:

- 1. **Written application:** Submit a completed membership application, sponsored by two **YGRC** members in good standing, and the dues for one year to the membership chair.
- 2. Participation requirements: Prospective members must attend two YANKEE meetings, or attend one meeting and work at one event, or work at two events, prior to becoming eligible for a full membership. Club meetings are usually on the fourth Tuesday of odd-number months, earlier in November, and usually at the Acton Congregational Church. Copies of the club constitution and bylaws are available at each meeting. All membership requirements must be completed within one year of application, else the application will expire and must be resubmitted.
- 3. **Being voted in:** After the reading of the application at a club meeting, publishing the application in the newsletter, and receiving notification of completion of all requirements, the Membership Chair will present the application for a vote at the next regularly scheduled club meeting.

Subscribers: Non-members can subscribe to the **YGRC** newsletter, *Finish Lines*, by completing the front page of the membership application and sending it with the fee of \$30 to the membership chair.

Renewals: During the month of November, a dues statement, payable by the first of February of the following year, will be mailed to each club member. No members may vote who have not paid their dues for the current year. A \$10 late fee is due for any payments after February 1.

A membership will be considered lapsed if the membership dues are not paid by February 1. Lapsed memberships receive none of the benefits of membership. A membership will be automatically terminated if the membership dues remain unpaid 90 days after the first day of the fiscal year, *i.e.*, April 1. To re-join the club, the applicant must complete the procedure described above.



GRCA DELEGATE REPORT

The following resolutions, approved by the GRCA's Board of Directors, are given here for the information of **YANKEE** members and require no action.

10-60. Approving the GRCA Health and Genetics Committee proposal for a Golden Retriever Electronic Health Survey as a joint project of

the GRF and GRCA, to be posted on the OFA website.

10-79. Appointing Angela Berkheimer McLean of Littleton CO to the position of National Specialty Financial Advisor.

10-80. Approving the *Florida Gulf Coast GRC* as a member club of GRCA.

10-81. Accepting the resignation of Howard Falberg with thanks for his many years of distinguished service, and appointing Ellen Hardin of Custer WI as GRCA's delegate to the AKC.

10-82. Approving reimbursement of a portion of expenses incurred by Ainslie Mills, Chairman of the Judges' Education Subcommittee, in conjunction with the judges' education presentation at the January 2011 Puyallup/ Tacoma show cluster.

Hot Topics

FROM THE GRCA HEALTH & GENETICS COMMITTEE: HEALTH UPDATES. New DNA research on pigmentary uveitis reminds us that it is very important for owners of dogs with blood samples deposited in the CHIC DNA Repository and at the Broad Institute to update their dog's status with reference to any diagnosis that has been made since the dog donated the sample. (This includes all dogs that have ever donated a blood sample at any National Specialty.) While all diseases are of interest, of particular importance are major diseases of often later onset such as pigmentary uveitis and cancers. It is essential that researchers have this information so that affected dogs can be correctly used in studies, and also to ensure that affected dogs do not confuse the data by being grouped with normal controls. Cause (when known) and date of death are also important. All



information will be kept confidential, and please do this as soon as possible because new studies are beginning. Thank you for your help, and please report health updates to both: The CHIC DNA Repository edziuk@offa.org and The Broad Institute dog-info@broadinstitute.org.

GRCA CODE OF ETHICS PROPOSAL FROM THE GRCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS & THE GRCA **HEALTH & GENETICS COMMITTEE. Pigmentary** uveitis is a hereditary, potentially painful eye disorder of Golden Retrievers, often not developing until 7 years of age or later. Early stages of the disease may not be apparent to Ιf not diagnosed early successfully treated, it can cause glaucoma and blindness. Even with the best available treatment, this disease sometimes results in glaucoma, and may require surgical removal of one or both eyes to relieve pain. Due to increasing prevalence of pigmentary uveitis in the breed, the GRCA Board of Directors is reviewing a recommendation by the Health & Genetics Committee (H&G) to make some changes in the Club's Code of Ethics. The substance of the proposal is that annual eye exams by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist be done on all Golden Retrievers that produce offspring, for the life of the dog, and further, that the examination reports be recorded in an online searchable database, e.g., CERF. The GRCA Board of Directors would like to hear from the membership regarding these proposed changes. Send your comments to Bev Brown, Western VP, lochinvarStudio@aol.com by March 31, 2010.

Test Know How seminar presented by Julie Cairns & Jim Drager, on October 30–


31 in Hollis NH.

YANKEE FALL HEALTH CLINICS REPORT



YGRC held our Fall Health Clinic on November 14, 2010, at Sudbury Animal Hospital in Sudbury, MA. We offered OFA Heart and CERF Eye clinics, as well as a microchip clinic and DNA blood draw for canine cancer research.

This year 149 dogs participated in the clinics. We saw many breeds, including Golden Retrievers, Labrador Retrievers, Belgian Tervuren, German Shepherd Dogs, Jack Russell and Rat terriers, Pugs, Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, an Afghan Hound and a Brittany. We had 53 non-member dogs participate, thanks to our members who posted flyers and spread the word about the clinic.

YANKEE BREEDER REFERRAL

Breeder Referral Listing & Newsletter Listing Policy

ANKEE GOLDEN RETRIEVER **CLUB** offers Breeder Referral a service to member breeders, stud dog owners, and prospective puppy owners. Acceptance of a listing does not guarantee placement of puppies, and does not constitute endorsement by the club or any of its members. Neither the club nor its Board of Directors assumes responsibility for the quality, health, soundness, or temperament of any litters listed. YANKEE recommends that a fully executed, written purchase agreement setting forth all the terms of purchase be obtained before possession of a puppy is transferred to a purchaser. YGRC members may list litters, older puppies, and adult dogs with the Breeder Referral Listing and in Finish Lines if the breeder/stud dog owner has been a member of YANKEE or another GRCA-member club for a minimum of one year, and submits the following:

- Copies of AKC registration certificates, thereby verifying that both the sire and dam were over 2 years old at the time of breeding.
- Eye clearances on both the sire and dam, issued by a veterinary ophthalmologist certified by the American College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists. Clearances must be current during the time the litter is listed. Eye clearances on dogs under 8 years of age are valid only for one year from the date of issue. CERF certificates will be accepted.
- Hip clearances on both the sire and dam. Dogs must have final OFA Certification, or PennHip Distraction Indexes below the median done at or after 6 months of age, with no radiographic evidence of hip dysplasia.
- Final heart clearances on both the sire and dam, issued by a veterinary cardiologist who is certified by the ACVIM (Cardiology).
- A Litter Listing Agreement, (see above, right) completed and signed, for each litter listed.

Send listings and copies of clearances to the YGRC Breeder Referral chair listed in back of this newsletter. Referral listings will run for 10 weeks; please contact the Breeder Referral chair to pull or to extend the listing.

The listing fee is \$30 per calendar year or \$5 per older puppy or adult. Litters listed with the Breeder Referral service are also listed in the newsletter. Please note: **YANKEE** members who own stud dogs may list litters sired by their dog when the breeder is not a **YGRC** member, provided the same listing criteria have been met by both sire and dam.


