DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS: UNIVERSITY OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DAIRY BAR/TRAIN STATION, DEPOT ROAD, DURHAM, NH

FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH: From I-95 take exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike, Routes 4 West and 16 North (left exit from the south). Just before the toll booths, take Exit 6W on the right, Route 4 West towards Durham and Concord. Follow Route 4 almost seven miles to the exit for Route 155A UNH, Durham. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A East and travel just over a mile, passing horse barns and greenhouses on your left and tennis courts on your right. Just past the hill over the railroad tracks, take a sharp left onto Depot Rd, adjacent to the large artificial turf athletic field. Proceed 50 yards to the Dairy Bar.

FROM THE MANCHESTER NH AREA: Take NH-101 East to Exit 7, Route 125. Turn left off the exit and follow Route 125 North more than nine miles to the traffic rotary and take the first exit onto Route 4 East. In two and a half miles, take the Route 155A exit (**not** 155, which you will come to first) and turn right off the ramp onto 155A east. Continue as above.

Note: A limited number of vehicles are allowed on campus during the test and we will be carpooling. Please leave un-entered dogs at home.

ENTRY FEE: \$75 for Tracking Dog and \$150 for Tracking Dog Excellent which includes AKC recording fee.

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 p.m. Thursday, April 17, 2014 at the Test Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

As required by Chapter 3, Section 2 of the AKC Tracking Regulations, a written certification must accompany the TD entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD test.

The drawings for entries and alternates will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. This TD/TDX Test is open to all breeds, with preference given to Golden Retrievers. If required by the numbers and types of entries, there shall be up to four drawings for TD and up to four for TDX, as shown in the following table.

The drawing will take place at the Test Secretary's home at 6:00 PM on Thursday, April 17, 2014. After the entry limit is reached in either TD or TDX, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the results of the draw by mail and/or e-mail. Entrants may call the Test Secretary until 9:00 p.m. concerning the results of the drawing. If you are not selected in the draw or elect to withdraw and would like your entry returned, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope; otherwise all such entries and checks will be shredded.

SUBSTITUTION OF TRACKS: In the event that there are insufficient TD or TDX entries, tracks may be substituted using the factor of 2 TDs = 1 TDX as specified in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

WITHDRAWALS: If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. The entry fee for an alternate that does not participate will be refunded within seven days after the test. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking fields only immediately prior to the running of their tracks. Please notify the Test Secretary as soon as you know your bitch is in season for this test.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
